## NABO REPORT

The 2014 NABO winter meeting was hosted by the San Francisco Basque Cultural Center over President's day weekend. As always, the San Francisco Basque Cultural Center sponsored a fantastic meeting, along with their February festival. From savory food, the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the San Francisco Klika, and great pelota games in both Esku and Joko-Garbi, the weekend festival was outstanding.

Topics of interest discussed at the meeting were Udaleku, which will be held in Elko and hosted by the Elko Euzkaldunak Club. It will take place from June 22 – July 4. The theme for the camp will be Bizkaia. Sign up and other information can be found at the NABO website. Look under the tab for Udaleku.

The National Mus tournament will be hosted by the Marin Sonoma Basque Club on May 31, while the International tournament will be held in Cancun, Mexico. Joe Eguiren/Javier Arrieta and Ben Badiola/John Badiola will be representing Euzkaldunak.

The newly established History Committee is focusing on a comprehensive Basque Oral History Project, which will interview Basque seniors (first) to get their stories before that generation passes. Luckily, our own Basque Museum has done a great job in acquiring these important histories for years now, and fortunately many of our other Basque communities are now securing these important first-hand generational accounts.

The 2014 NABO Calendar is still available at the Basque Museum. The 2014 calendar profiles Basque books published by UNR, with a link which a person can use in order to read short passages from that month's featured book.

There were five Bizi Emankorra Award Honorees for 2014. They are Martin Minaberry from the Basque Educational Organization, Father Lastiri from the Fresno Basque Club, and Martin Etchamendy, Marilou Onaindia, and Frank Maitis from the Kern County Basque Club. The Bizi Emankorra Award in NABO's Lifetime Achievement Award.

NABO pelota finals took place during the San Inazio festival with teams from Bakersfield winning the men's Class A Doubles Esku and Class B Paleta Goma, titles, and San Francisco winning the Class A Paleta Goma title. Boise teams fought hard in all of these tournaments. Exhibition games in Baleen were also played with our local women doing a great job representing the sport. In August, NABO helped sponsor a pilota coach from Euskadi who held clinics in Boise, and San Francisco. While in Boise there were clinics held for adults in the area of pala and baleen, and a youth clinic which was well attended by our local kids.

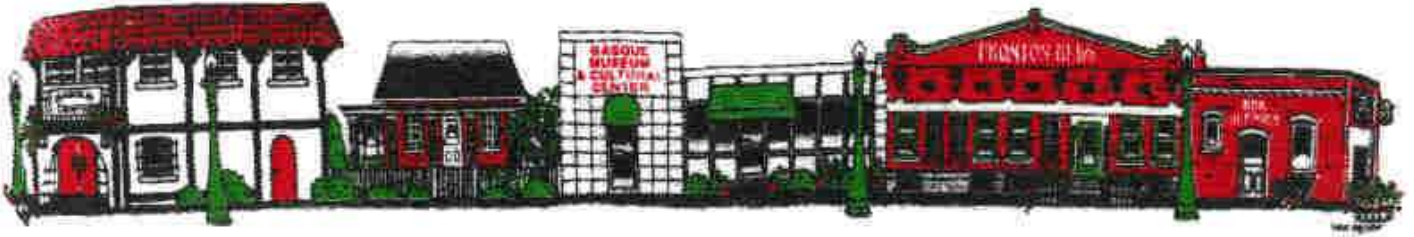
