





NABO UPDATE

This year's Winter meeting was graciously hosted by the Utah Basque Club in conjunction with their annual dinner and dance on January 31. The meeting was well attended by many delegates as well as a contingent from the Basque Government, Boise's new Basque priest Fr. Anton Egiguren, and Joseba Etxarri from euskalkultura.com. Many issues were discussed and voted on, with the main topics described below.

There were four, well-deserving nominees for the NABO's Bizi Emankorra, lifetime achievement award, which included Joseba Etxarri, Boise Euzkaldunak's very own John Ysursa, Benan Oregi, and Izaskun Kortizar. These individuals will receive their awards during the next NABO meeting, which will be held in Boise on Friday of Jaialdi weekend.

Udaleku 2015 will take place in San Francisco from June 21 – July 3. The theme will be Iparralde, with a special emphasis on the province of Zuberoa. Cost for the two-week camp will be \$375.00. Euzkaldunak is offering scholarships to assist with the cost of the camp. There is also financial assistance available through NABO's Aita Tillous fund for those families with a financial need. NABO wants to make sure no interested child is excluded from attending camp because of a lack of financial resources. Online registration will open March 1 at 7:00 PM (MST). Registration fills up extremely fast, with all spots being filled within 30 minutes during the last two years.

Many exciting efforts are taking place within the History committee of NABO. The California Historical Society has been working with NABO and the Basque government regarding an exhibit called "Basques in California." Once completed, the exhibit will travel throughout the state discussing the significant role Basques played throughout California's extraordinary history.

Also, with the assistance of Steve Bass and Patty Miller, many of our Basque clubs are identifying and interviewing older Basques, and some non-Basques, to record those integral histories that may be lost as this elder generation passes. Without

these interviewing and archiving efforts, much of the history and knowledge of our past may vanish.

The international Mus tournament was held in Cancun, Mexico back in October of 2014. Representing the United States was Tony and Darren Uranga from Homedale's Txoko Ona club. Darren and Tony did an outstanding job representing the United States, and came in 4th place overall.

The 2015 national tournament will be held in Homedale on May 30, with the international tournament being held in Mar del Plata, Argentina. Euzkaldunak held their 2015 NABO tournament earlier in January, with the team of John Krakau and Sean Aucutt being victorious, and will represent Boise in Homedale on May 30. The Junior Mus national tournament will be held in Boise on July 31. Clubs are encouraged to have their representatives' names submitted to NABO Jr. Mus Chair, Gina Espinal, at juniormus@nabasque.org by June 19. Hopefully there will be teams representing all of our Idaho clubs.

There are two vacant committee chairs for Dance and Pilota. 
