The first dancing practice will be on Tuesday, September 25, at 7:00 PM.

Registration:

Online registration for Boiseko Gazteak will begin on Tuesday, September 4. It will be accessible until Tuesday, September 18. You will receive an email notification when registration opens with links to the registration documents. You may also register in person on **September 18 at 7:00 PM** at the Basque Center. Whether you register online or not, you will need to come to the Basque Center that evening if you need to have your children measured for costumes, have costumes altered, or purchase used costumes, shoes, and other costume accessories. This evening will also be an opportunity to sell your used costume to another parent (if you are selling a costume, please plan to arrive early so that the costume pieces can be priced prior to registration).


