Efforts begin **Tuesday, October 30**, at Fiddlers Green Farm (see directions below). Same location as 2017. Drop in anytime between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM to help prepare the onions and leeks.

Wednesday, October 31, we will be cooking the onions and leeks from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

Thursday, November 1, at the Basque Center, we will make the morzillas in two shifts: 7:00 AM to 12:30 PM, and 1:00 PM until 5:00 PM. A lunch for both shifts will be served at the break - at approximately 12:30 PM.

If you can't help out on either of those days, consider **Friday**, **November 2**, at the Basque Center from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM, when we will be packaging the morzillas.
