PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

You may have noticed some changes within the Basque Center, especially if you recently attended a Euzkaldunak members dinner or event (i.e. Mus Tournament). The Basque Center Bar, LLC is the owner/holder of our liquor permit. Whenever there is an event outside the physical bar area, including the dance hall, cardroom or basement that will serve liquor, we need to obtain a one-time Alcohol Beverage Catering Permit. There are several requirements that the city has imposed for those obtaining any Alcohol Beverage Catering Permit and compliance with those requirements have necessitated change:

- Any server of alcohol must have valid server training per Boise City Code 5-7-2 (within the last 3 years)
- All entrances and exits must be staffed by an employee of the catering company, host establishment, or private security company hired by the event.
- Identification must be checked by staff to ensure service to those 21 or older.

We have made the necessary changes to avoid any violations and potential negative impact to our liquor permit and we appreciate your help in supporting these changes.




BASQUE MUSEUM BENEFIT DINNER & AUCTION APRIL 6
