

EUZKALDUNAK 2020 GENERAL MEETING & ELECTION RECAP

The general meeting, which serves as the annual membership meeting for all Euzkaldunak members, began at 7:30 PM on January 25. Ed Orbea opened the meeting by welcoming everyone. He thanked the Ikastola for hosting the dinner and thanked outgoing board members Martin Bilbao, Bryan Day, Tyler Smith and Sarah Urizar-Smith.

Ricardo Yanci presented the nominees for the five open board positions: Martin Bilbao, Ed Orbea, Tyler Smith, Todor Azurtza, Isana Urquidi, and Mike Franzoia. There were no nominations from the floor and there was a motion and second that nominations cease. Members were asked to vote for 5 candidates. The ballots were collected and taken to the office to be counted. Argia Beristain ran unopposed and will continue as the NABO delegate.

Ed presented the 2019 financials. He explained the increase in legal and accounting costs to address and resolve the catering and license issues impacting events in the hall. The board is continuing to work with the city on this issue. Ed thanked all the volunteers who helped make our events such as San Inazio, the Morzilla dinner, and Sheepherders Ball a huge success. An Economic Impact Assessment was done by the Boise Convention and Visitors Bureau that showed San Inazio produced an economic impact of \$225,000 for the city of Boise.

Alicia Knox gave an update on the renovation plans. She explained a renovation committee was formed with past presidents, former renovation committee members, subject matter experts, and members representing various decades. The purpose of the committee is to help guide and make recommendations to the Board of Directors regarding a potential renovation, round out areas that may not be the Board's expertise, and bring perspectives that may not have been brought up in Board meetings. Argia presented a brief NABO report. She began by thanking the membership for letting her serve as the delegate for the past two years. Argia noted Udaleku 2020 would be in Salt Lake City, UT June 21–July 3 and will focus on the province of Gipuzkoa. A new program, Ateak Ireki, is for youth ages 16-25 to experience life and culture in the Basque Country will take place June 29–July 19, 2020, with participants welcomed by host families in the Goierri Valley of Gipuzkoa, as well as study at the renowned <u>Maizpide Barnetegi</u> in Lazkao. Lastly, the 2020 NABO Mus Finals will be held 06/20/20 in Los Banos, CA.

Ricardo finished the meeting by announcing those elected to the 2020 board of directors; Martin Bilbao, Tyler Smith, Isana Urquidi, Todor Azurtza, and Mike Franzoia. Ed Orbea is the 2020 alternate. The Board met upstairs and elected Martin Bilbao President, Tyler Smith Vice President, and Ricardo Yanci as the NABO Representative.

ATEAK IREKI CULTURAL EXCHANGE

In partnership with NABO, Batzen (an organization from the Basque Country) is launching a new program aimed at engaging youth in our communities ages 16-25. Inspired by the Boise State Basque Studies/Oñati exchanges of the 1970s, the idea is to engage youth who have Basque ancestry or are interested in Basque Culture after they are no longer able to attend Udaleku. This three-week immersion in life in the Basque Country today will be hosted this year in the Goierri Valley, Gipuzkoa from June 29–July 19, 2020. Youth will live with families that have youth of a similar age and interest, and they will study at the Maizpide Barnetegi as well as visit and learn about various aspects of Basque culture and business today.

The Ateak Ireki program in 2020 is FREE to

participants. The only expenses will be flights to/from the Basque Country and pocket/spending money while they are participating in the program. Registration opens on February 1 and those interested are encouraged to apply as soon as possible as they can only take 50 participants in 2020. 
