As you may know, the Basque Center facility (hall, kitchen, card room, basement, and bar) is fully closed until further notice. <u>The April and May</u> <u>monthly dinners are also cancelled</u>, not only to comply with City of Boise and State of Idaho shelter-in-place orders, but to protect Euzkaldunak members and patrons from the community spread of COVID-19.

In addition, the Jaialdi committee has also made the difficult decision to postpone Jaialdi until summer 2021. You can read the full notice on the last page of this newsletter.

The Euzkaldunak board has been closely monitoring local, state, and national health guidelines and regulations as the COVID-19 situation develops, and we will continue to act with our members' and the larger community's safety in mind.

In these truly unprecedented times, the Basque community we have built together is more important than ever. 
