BASQUE CENTER FACILITY UPDATES

The Euzkaldunak Board of Directors is continuing to closely follow COVID-19 state and local guidance and statistics with regard to opening the Basque Center Bar and the larger facility. As of our June 15 board meeting, there has been an uptick of confirmed COVID-19 cases following Phase 3 of reopening, so we are especially cautious about reopening until it's safe to do so. The board will reevaluate each month at our regularly scheduled board meeting, but for now, the Basque Center Bar and Hall will remain closed.

Once the Basque Center bar does reopen, we will be following state guidelines and protocols for sanitation and physical distancing to ensure the safety of employees, members and guests.

We have also finished progress on refinishing the floor in the dance hall. This was an existing project planned for summer 2020, and we were able to take advantage of the hall being closed to the public to complete the project sooner.

SAN INAZIO 2020 CANCELED

After much deliberation, the Euzkaldunak Board of Directors has made the difficult decision to **NOT hold a San Inazio festival this year.** Once Jaialdi was postponed to 2021, there was the question of holding the San Inazio festival in its stead. However, in order to follow physical distancing guidelines for large gatherings we simply cannot hold a festival like San Inazio, even outdoors. This wasn't an easy decision to make, but we believe it's the best way that Euzkaldunak can help keep members, staff and guests safe.

Often people in our festivals, when they see a bertso session, unable to understand what they hear, criticize it. They say that the show is slow, that the aesthetics are flat, that the singers have a poor voice, that music is missing...

I will try to explain in these verses the lyric of bertsos, and why it is such a beautiful old custom of ours.


We do not go to a bertso session to hear good voices; even if singing is involved bertsolaritza is not Opera.

Bertsolaritza is poetry, putting together words, syllables and rhymes. Furthermore, it is improvised poetry. Transmitting feelings and emotions to the heart, the bertsolari aims to move the viewer.


We continue trying to explain this art form... The key to understand these word games lies in the language since, unless you recognize the gist of the words, everything is incomprehensible.

Our language gives life to the bertsos, but on the other hand, bertsolaritza supports Euskara, this tradition keeping our ancestors' language alive.
