
Euzkaldunak Charter Members

The Basque community incorporated as Euzkaldunak in 1949. The elected officers and board members of the new organization worked hard to bring together a membership from Boise and neighboring towns. Euzkaldunak's main goal was to have their own "gathering place"—a Basque Center.

The annual General Meeting on January 7, 1951, was held at Eagles Hall. From the minutes: "Mr. Bastida [Vice President] stated that we [Board of Directors] plan on having a plaque with the members' names on it, those of 1951 membership being chartered members." The issue of membership dues was discussed. It was decided to leave the dues at \$5 per person... "we will need the money for our building program." In addition to paying the dues, the charter members would also meet these criteria: they must be Basque or married to a Basque, and they must be 18 years of age or older.

It was at this annual meeting in 1951 that the membership expressed an interest in having their building in Boise's downtown area. The Board was given the authority to proceed with the purchase of the lot, which was completed in February. Euzkaldunak's Basque Center was to be located on the SW corner of the intersection at 6th & Grove Streets. The building was completed before the end of the year, and the 1952 Annual General Meeting on January 12 was held in the new Basque Center. Also ready was the register for signatures for the list of charter members.







Euzkaldunak Charter Members (cont'd)

The collection of names took place over several weeks. Eventually, 516 people "signed" the charter register. The charter member list and the membership of Euzkaldunak came under the direction of Carmen Solosabal—something she would manage for many years to come.

Some trivia regarding the Charter Member list: the first name on the alphabetic list was Agustin ABADIA, the last was Phyllis "Felisa" Mendiola ZUBIZARRETA; the four most common surnames were ALDAPE, ALDECOA, BICANDI, UBERUAGA—and they represent 54 last names among the 516 charter members; many of the charter members were from neighboring towns—Nampa, Meridian, Homedale, Marsing, Emmett, Mountain Home, Caldwell; there were many single men living in various boarding houses who joined and were charter members.

Among the 516 original charter members, six are still with us today. As they registered their names (in 1951 through the beginning of 1952), they are: REGINA BASTIDA ALDECOA, JOANNE ALDRICH, ROSITA ALEGRIA ARTIS, LYDIA GOIRI (married J Black), JOHN LASUEN, and JULIA UBERUAGA (married K Coleman). We appreciate our charter members!

Our oldest charter member is Regina, who was 99 on Three Kings Day (January 6, 2021). Julia Uberuaga will be 99 on June 12, 2021. Julie lived in the boarding house next door; she and her brother Joe served in several capacities in the early days of the organization as recorders and keepers of minutes. Julia was also a volunteer who accepted membership payments and passed out membership cards at various events and dances. Regina and Julia have been members and donors to the Basque Center for 70 years—the entire duration of the Euzkaldunak charter.

Recently it came to our attention that one of our charter members has died, and very few people were aware of her passing. Sadly, we say "Goian Bego" to PRISCILLA SAIZAR (married S Waller)—February 9, 1926 – December 15, 2019. Priscilla lived with her family in the Basque neighborhood on 5th Street. Priscilla's family preceded her in death, and she had limited visitation at the care unit where she lived for the last five years of her life. We have fond memories of Priscilla, one of the "red-skirted girls" who danced the jota in the "Song of the Basque" in 1949.

GOIAN BEGO ~ REST IN PEACE


