History Corner: Ladies' Organizations

The History Corner of the Euzkaldunak newsletter has been educational and interesting as we have read about the great steps that our parents and grandparents took to build and organize the Basque Center. So many families participated and donated their time and energy to make Euzkaldunak the huge success that we have enjoyed for all of these years. Our recent newsletters have explained the activities that began—mostly by the men—with ideas and assistance from the women.

In 1936, several Basque women organized a social group called the Knitting Club—also called The Basque Girls' Club. At the time, knitting was very popular; and the ladies decided that they could enjoy visiting, along with knitting or sewing, one afternoon a week. It wasn't long before the knitting fell by the wayside, and the social aspects of gathering became much more important. The ladies met at different homes each week and always had a fantastic time.

One of their best events was the annual Halloween party. Each member came in a great costume; they played crazy games, drank a few cocktails, and enjoyed hours of fun.

Throughout the Club's history, the ladies participated in various activities and charitable events. In early years, they helped out at the Nampa State School, made bandages for the Red Cross, and stuffed envelopes for charities. They organized and worked at the Basque Center Bazaar each November, sponsoring games for children such as the Fish Pond, selling homemade toys and Christmas stockings, and offering home-prepared foods and baked goods. In the early days of the

growth of Euzkaldunak, they organized dances or headed committees. They also helped with the many dinners sponsored by Euzkaldunak fundraisers by preparing and serving food and cleaning before and after events. They took on projects including making curtains, sponsoring contests at Basque Picnics or joining in morzilla or chorizo making. The families of the Knitting Club members can testify how important "Club" was to their amas, amumas and tias. And the Knitting Club was important to the development and activities in our Basque community.

Ladies' Organizations (pt 2/3)



At some point in the 1980s, the Knitting Club closed the membership to new members. They didn't want the group to become so large that the members could not fit in their living rooms. Throughout its history, the Knitting Club had a total of 86 members, some for just a short time in the early years.



In October of 1986, the Basque Girls' Club celebrated "The Golden Years," the 50th anniversary and reunion of the group. A big party was held at the Basque Center, hosted by

Euzkaldunak, Aiztan Artean, and families of the Club members. A small brochure provided some information about the women who were or who had been members.
