SHEPHERDERS BALL & BASQUE FOUNDATION CHARITIES - PRIMARY RECIPIENT



The first Shepherders Ball was held in 1929 after John Archabal convinced two Basque men's organizations to combine their annual Christmas dances into 1 unified event. There is no definitive information when the name "Shepherders Ball" was adopted, but the idea has always been the same: an annual dance for Basques. In 1974 the Shepherders Ball was the first one open to the public and had close to 1000 participants. Basil and Dorothy Bicandi Aldecoa donated a lamb for the annual lamb auction for charity, which earned \$2,205 from 16 different bidders. The Basque Foundation Charities has benefitted ever since from the Shepherders Ball and Lamb Auction.

This year the pandemic has forced the Euzkaldunak Board of Directors to cancel the in-person Shepherders Ball; however, the charitable donations are still needed. This year, the Basque Foundation Charities selected the Gammon Family as their primary recipient.

In early August 2021, Matt and Shelley Gammon noticed that their 8-year old son Blake had begun to act differently. He had decreased energy, pain through his legs and hips, and frequent headaches. As any parent would, they took notice but figured it was the typical growth spurt, until out of nowhere Blake turned yellow. They immediately took him to the doctor where they did bloodwork to try and find answers. That's when The Gammon's lives all changed. On September 29, 2021 Matt and Shelley received devastating news that Blake was diagnosed with B-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. This diagnosis comes with roughly three years of chemotherapy treatments, many hospital stays, countless doctor's appointments and so many other hardships.

While the Gammon family has medical insurance, the medical expenses from this diagnosis and the amount of work that will be missed to care for their child will be significant.

**EDUCATION NEWS: BASQUE DIASPORA
MASTER'S PROGRAM**

Nere Lete, MFA., and Ziortza Gandarias Beldarrain, PhD., professors of [Basque Studies](#) in the World Languages Department at Boise State University were invited to teach a course in the inaugural session of the Master's degree program created by the University of the Basque Country, "[Specialization in Basque Diaspora](#)" (30 credits). This Master's degree in Basque Diaspora is intended to be a training program with a clear international and inter-university orientation. In fact, the students are from the Basque Country and other Basque Diaspora communities, such as Argentina, Peru, Uruguay, and Venezuela.

Lete and Gandarias Beldarrain taught the class "Diáspora y género: el rol de la mujer" (Diaspora and Gender: The Role of Women) in Spanish on November 4th, to the 25 students of the master. The professors enlisted Patty Miller to provide her expertise as the Director of [Community History Project](#) at the Basque Museum & Cultural Center in Boise. They presented a multidisciplinary course, analyzing the formations of different diasporas in the American West and the role of women in these communities. The course latter focused on the active role and presence of Basque women in the diasporic community of the American West. The ultimate goal was to showcase the contributions these women have made and continue making in the social, cultural, political, historical and economic arenas in Boise, Idaho.

History Corner: Boiseko Gazteak

History Corner is a featured column in the Euzkaldunak newsletter that is written by members of the Basque Center Renovation Committee. Our 7-decade old building is aging and needs our enthusiasm and support to carry our traditions forward for the next 7 decades and beyond. The goal of the History Corner column is to highlight the many beloved traditions we can carry out thanks to having access to a Basque Center and to educate members about our rich Boise Basque history.

Even before Euzkaldunak was established and before there was a Basque Center, Basque dancing lessons took place in our community. The credit goes to Juanita Uberuaga for getting it all started. In a future newsletter, we will talk about how we got to where we are today with Boiseko Gazteak, the *Young Ones from Boise*. Children from ages 4 to 14



meet in the Basque Block—Basque Center hall and basement, Fronton, Museum, even in the street on Grove—on Tuesday evenings to practice dancing. **It takes the whole village to make this happen.**

The “Txikituak” are the 4- and 5-year-old *Little Ones*. They are the audience pleasers who put a smile on everyone’s face. Their teachers (sometimes called “cat herders”) are Patxi Kerns, Amaya Odiaga, Tere Achabal Papapietro and Mark Uranga. Musicians are Dan Ansotegui, Tamara Shapiro Ansotegui, Chris Bieter and Bonnie Shuster.

“Azkarrak” are 6-7 years of age. They are the *Smart Quick Ones*. Musicians are Johnny Boyd and Nikki Totorica; teachers are Jill Aldape, Argia Beristain, Jude Gary and Alicia Knox.

The 8-10 olds are the “Txulitoak” or the *Proud Ones*. Their teachers and musicians are Johnny Aldape, Amaya Fischer, Alicia Lachiondo, Michelle Lauer, Miren Lete, Gaizka Malone, Linda Mainvil-Fischer and James Sangroniz.



The oldest group of dancers from ages 11-14 is “Nagusiak.” These dancers at the top level are the *Bosses or Chiefs*. Their teachers and musicians—all of whom are past or current members of Oinkaris—are Ellie Ansotegui, Ben Bengoetxea, Teresa Franzoia, Jaclyn Lasuen, Tyler Smith and Isana Urquidi.

JAIALDI POSTPONED UNTIL 2025

By now, most of you have heard that the Jaialdi team made the tough decision to cancel Jaialdi 2022.

The simple fact of the matter is this: We're still in the midst of a pandemic, and we couldn't in good conscience invite people to one of the biggest festivals in the state without limiting the number of people who could attend or trying to curb the ticket-free gathering on the Basque Block. As we saw over the summer, when Idaho hospitals resorted to critical standards of care, warm weather does not necessarily mean the virus is less rampant. We can't predict the future or the restrictions the city will place on gatherings if our case numbers skyrocket again.

This wasn't a decision we made lightly, especially after postponing the festival twice, but we couldn't put our volunteers, our lodging partners, our sponsors, and attendees through yet another postponement that may or may not have worked.

We understand that people are disappointed. We are, too. But we're very much looking forward to gathering in 2025! In the meantime, here are a few things you should know:

- We are finalizing the way ticket refunds for events at Expo Idaho will work and hope to share that information with you soon. All other event refunds were processed previously.
- Please contact your hotel to reschedule your room dates.
- Please contact your airline to cancel your tickets.
- Our vendor coordinator will be in touch with vendors to issue refunds.
- We will follow up with every person or business who reserved space in the program book and will issue refunds.
- The cancelation of Jaialdi 2022 will not affect the timing of the next Jaialdi. That festival is still scheduled to take place during the last week of July in 2025.

Your patience and support has meant the world to us. Thank you so much for helping us bring this festival to Boise and our friends around the country and the world.



INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE BASQUE LANGUAGE

Every year on December 3, Euskara is celebrated all around the world and this holiday is known as the International Day of the Basque Language. The date for this holiday was established in 1948 by Eusko Ikaskuntza, the Society for Basque Studies. They chose December 3 because it's the feast day of Saint Francis Xavier, co-patron saint of the Basque province of Nafarroa (along with San Fermín).

Born in Xabier, Nafarroa in the 16th century, Saint Francis Xavier was a companion of Saint Ignatius of Loyola and one of the first Jesuits. He went on missions throughout Asia, and he is said to have converted the most people to Christianity since Saint Paul. Saint Francis Xavier died on an island off the coast of mainland China, apparently speaking his last words in Euskara, his native language.

The Basque Government and Euskaltzaindia, the Academy of the Basque Language, officially institutionalized the International Day of the Basque Language in 1995. In the past, Basque institutions and clubs around the world have celebrated the day with different events: concerts, lectures, singing and language workshops, meals, dance performances, film screenings. It's a marvel that Euskara, the Basque language, has survived for thousands of years, and on the 3rd of December we celebrate this accomplishment. It is our hope for it to continue to flourish for years to come, with the help of programs like Euskaraldia and the will of the Basque people.

EUSKARALDIA IS NOV 23 - DEC 3

Euskaraldia is a project in which people in all 7 provinces in the Basque Country are encouraged to speak more Euskara, the Basque language, over an 11-day period from Nov 23-Dec 3. Participants can sign up at euskaraldia.eus as either an Euskara speaker, *ahobizi*, or an Euskara listener, *bellariprest*, during these 11 days. *Ahobizi* commit to starting all of their conversations and social interactions in Euskara. They can of course switch to another language if the person they are speaking to doesn't understand Euskara, but just starting a conversation in Euskara sets the tone. *Bellariprest* ask Euskara speakers to speak to them in Euskara. This way, they can better practice their comprehension and support the use of Euskara in everyday life.



DIASPORA STUDY



Keara Dennehy from Dartmouth College is conducting research about Basque identity and community in Boise in December 2021. The project will ask questions about historical and current ideas of what it means to

be Basque, the role that the sheepherding industry has played in the Boise community, and the specific experiences of Basque-American women. The primary benefits of this study will be knowledge gained for future Basque-Americans and contribution to the broader field of diaspora studies. Keara will tentatively be traveling to Boise in December to interview 20 members of the Boise Basque community. Interviews will take up to one hour and can be anonymized upon interviewees' request, and will be conducted via Zoom, or in person if Keara is able to visit Boise.
