#### **EUZKALDUNAK BOARD ELECTIONS**

This year we have seven candidates for five positions and an alternate for the Board of Directors. You can read about each candidate in the bios section on the next page of this newsletter.

Since we will not be holding an in-person annual meeting, the board has decided to run elections through an online service called Election Buddy. The elections for the Board of Directors will begin on January 24 and end on February 12. Members will receive a voting notice via email, text messaging, or mail, depending on what is listed with your membership. It is very important that you provide a valid email, text, and/or mailing address during your 2022 membership renewal so we can ensure every eligible member has the opportunity to cast a vote.

For those households who have the same email address for more than one member, please ensure the additional members in the household have another form of contact to receive the 2022 election ballots. If you're unsure what you have on file, please email <u>secretary@basquecenter.com</u>. For members who do not have email or a cell phone attached with their membership, they will receive a mailed ballot which will have a reference code for the member to vote online or mail or drop off the ballot to the Basque Center.


Please have patience with the board during this process; we are working our best to make it easy on all members while being able to continue with our normal business operations of our annual elections.


#### **BOISEKO & OLENTZERO THANK YOUS**

#### **History Corner: Boiseko Gazteak (part 2)**

Since Boiseko Gazteak is such a big part of our Boise Basque History, we will be taking more than one issue to report on this rich cultural tradition. Last month, we wrote an overview of the organization and how each age group is organized. This month, we'll hear from Boiseko Gazteak alumni about their experience as dancers, and then coming back to Boiseko as teachers in adulthood.



Patxi Kerns: I used to practice every week and then get so nervous that I would go sit on Amuma's lap during the performance and watch all my friends. I eventually got over that and LOVED being an Oinkari and performing in front of big crowds. So, I connect so much with the kids who don't want to be seen!

Jaclyn Lasuen: I have such fond thoughts of my instructors and peers in Boiseko who have gone on to become some of my closest friends and mentors in Oinkaris and beyond. If it weren't for little kids' dancing, I doubt I would have been a

dancer at all, which has given me some of my warmest memories and most unique opportunities to date. (Editor's note: Jaclyn carpooled with other dancers from Mountain Home every Tuesday during her time at Boiseko, and is now also the Oinkari Women's Dance Director. We love to see full circle Basque dance journeys!)



Isana Urquidi: I danced in Boiseko from Txikis through Nagusiak. I had many teachers through the years that were family members such as Autumn Laidlaw and my own mom. It is great that I get to follow in their footsteps and teach the next generation. One distinct memory is that after practice if we were good and listened to the teachers we got to go to the bar and have an Orangina or Shirley Temple.

Johnny Aldape: I did not particularly like going to "Little Kids" practice, because The A-Team aired Tuesdays on TV at the same time. We would usually stop by Amuma & Papa's house

(Lydia and Louie Jausoro) either before or after practice, and they were good about bribing my sister Jill and me with money or toys to keep us interested in dancing. I now appreciate how important Boiseko Gazteak was in my life, as it led me to join Oinkaris, which came with so many amazing opportunities and meeting lifetime friends. I hope that our work today will lead to the same awesome experiences for my own children and all the other young dancers.
