EUZKALDUNAK ANNUAL MEETING & ELECTION RECAP

Thank you to all the members who attended the 2023 Membership Dinner and Annual Meeting on January 27. The meeting began with our president, Ed Orbea, welcoming those in attendance and calling the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. He began by recognizing Sara Artis, Annie Gavica, and the Ikastola parents for hosting the dinner. He then recognized Albert Totorica, rental manager; Lael Uberuaga, newsletter editor; Julian Lete, facility manager; Patty Gabica, secretary/ treasurer; Jesus Alcelay, Miren Urresti and the kitchen staff. He later recognized Alex Wray, Oinkari President; and Johnny Aldape, Boiseko Gazteak director; and John Lejardi, Txoko Ona president. Ed recognized the retiring board members, Ryan Boyd, Johnny Boyd, Ricardo Yanci, and Alicia Knox.

He then turned the meeting over to Alicia for election of the Euzkaldunak Board of Directors. Candidates were Jenny Aldape, Mark Bieter, Romy Leichtfuss, Bernice Madariaga, Joe Mueleman and Ed Orbea, with no further nominations. Each of the 6 candidates gave a brief bio including why they'd like to be on the board. Members were asked to vote for 5 of the 6 candidates.

Alicia then introduced Argia Beristain, N.A.B.O. delegate candidate. There were no additional nominations for candidates, and Argia was elected to a subsequent 2-year term as N.A.B.O. Representative for Basque Foundation, Inc.

Ed led a discussion on the 2022 Financial Report. He mentioned the efforts of the International Mus Tournament Planning Committee and thanked Tyler Smith, Martin Bilbao, Ana Mendiola, Annie Gavica, and Mike Franzoia for their efforts. The Tournament was such a success that we have set the standard for future International Mus Tournaments. Ed mentioned that an Investment Committee was formed in 2021. Their purpose is long-term oversight of Basque Foundation funds. He then discussed some of the accounts that make up Euzkaldunak's portfolio.







ANNUAL MEETING RECAP, CONT'D

Alicia presented a brief report of the Renovation Committee. The committee is made up of members with diverse areas of expertise. The committee was formed in 2019 to define a plan to be brought to the membership for a building renovation. The last major renovation was in 1972. Alicia noted that we want to stay in this building at 6th and Grove. We have to keep our aging building up to date and accommodating for our purposes. There are safety issues being considered and addressed in the planning. When the phases of planning are complete the plan will be submitted to the membership for approval.

Ricardo and Argia presented a N.A.B.O. report. The Lifetime Achievement Award has been renamed for N.A.B.O. founder Al Erquiaga. There are 62 students in Boise learning Euskara. Last year's Udaleku was held in Bakersfield, CA with 89 participants. 22 kids from Idaho attended. Boise is hosting the 2023 Udaleku from July 20-28. Argia explained the importance of the camp and the lifetime friendships gained. She asked members to consider hosting kids attending this summer's camp. Host families provide lodging and transportation. The camp will provide meals, classes, and activities.

Mike went through the 2023 Euzkaldunak event calendar, including monthly dinner dates and major annual events. He asked everyone to check their newsletters for dates and details.

Alicia thanked the board for their work and then announced the 2023 board after votes were tallied. Joining Isana Bengoetxea, Joseba Criswell, Christina Gamboa, Gina Gridley, and Mike Franzoia are new directors Jenny Aldape, Romy Leichtfuss, Bernice Madariaga, Mark Bieter and Ed Orbea. Joe Meuleman is the alternate. Members were thanked for their support. There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned.

The new board met in the cardroom to elect officers. Ed Orbea was reelected as President, Mike Franzoia was elected as Vice President and Mark Bieter was elected as the Board N.A.B.O. Delegate.



UDALEKU 2023 - BOISE, IDAHO

Boise is hosting Udaleku from July 20-28, 2023. Formerly known as Music Camp, Udaleku came into being in April 1973 when various Basque clubs joined together to create the North American Basque Organizations (N.A.B.O.) with the purpose of promoting and encouraging our common Basque heritage. Since those early days the bonds between Basques here in the United States have been strengthened and extended. The annual Udaleku sponsored by N.A.B.O., and hosted by one of our member organizations, has contributed much to this growth.

The first camp was held in Boise (Bogus Basin) in 1973. Since then, hundreds of young Basques have gathered each summer in a different city of the extended Basque community in the United States. Under the direction of local and visiting talent from Europe, participants study Basque folk dance, music, singing and games (such as the card game mus, and pala/pilota).

Besides being a good learning experience, the camp offers the participants a great opportunity to develop ties and friendships with other young Basques from many states whose parents and ancestors came from both the northern and southern parts of "Euskal Herria" or the Basque country. The relationships formed over the ten-day period increases the present and future interaction between all of our Basque clubs. Udaleku is a unique experience for both the participants--who meet other Basques from other communities--and for the opportunity to teach younger generations of Basque-Americans about their culture. The camp is meant to impart to young Basque-Americans an appreciation for the uniqueness of their heritage.
