OINKARI v. ALUMNI SOFTBALL GAME



MEMBERSHIP DINNER PRICES

As the cost of living continues to rise, the Euzkaldunak Board of Directors is considering increasing the monthly dinner prices. While this decision can be difficult, it is important to understand the reasons behind it and the potential impact on members. One of the main reasons for a possible increase in dinner prices is the financial impact of rising costs of food and beverages. Making a profit from the monthly dinners has never been a goal. However, we would like to break even while providing a great atmosphere for people to meet/greet/dine: "Jateko eta edateko jakitea nahikoa da jakitea."

The Board will be sending out an email survey looking for feedback on possible options and soliciting your thoughts on options the Board might not have considered. These options are:

- Increase per-dinner prices
- Charge a dinner flat-rate regardless of membership status
- Wine for purchase (per glass or bottle)
- Utilize an on-line prepay process and not issue a refund to no-shows
- Decrease the frequency of dinners
- Implement limits on number of diners
- Minimize or otherwise control the number of gratis dinners provide to host families

If changes are indeed made, we will communicate that information to the membership, well before the September "Welcome Back" Dinner on Saturday, September 16, 2023.


