Euzkaldunak, Inc. was chartered in 1949 as a non-profit organization with the mission to promote Basque culture in the Boise area as well as the state of Idaho. The Basque Center was built in 1951 and acts as the primary home for our two dancing groups, Boiseko Gazteak, which teaches children from 4 to 13 years of age, and the Oinkari Basque Dancers, a performance troupe for ages 14 and older. The Center is also home for a Basque music group, Txantxangorriak, that plays traditional music at many of the Basque festivals. Annually we hold tournaments for two traditional Basque card games, Mus and Briska. There is a public bar with cheap drinks and the best bartenders in town. The Basque Center also has a dance hall and commercial kitchen that is available to rent all year long.

**WHAT:** Euzkaldunak, Inc. and the Basque Center are working towards a capital campaign for a renovated Basque Center.

**WHY:** The renovation completes several project to bring the Center up to current building codes. More importantly it sets the Center up for greater success in both promoting the Basque culture with education and arts and creating a more self-sustaining Center for future generations.

**WHY NOW:** As Boise continues to grow, we need to evolve with the vibrancy of our neighbors, especially being in the downtown area.
