# UDALEKU 2025 IN ELKO



# FIGHTING BASQUES: HONORING THE LEGACY OF BASQUE WWII HEROES

Since 2015, the non-profit history association Sancho de Beurko has led the international research project "Fighting Basques: Memory of World War II". The project sheds light on the vital contributions of Basques from both the Homeland and the diaspora to the Allied war effort in countries such as Australia, France, the former Soviet Union, the United Kingdom, and the United States during World War II. Sancho de Beurko's efforts also focuses on commemoration, education, and advocacy, ensuring that the stories of the brave men and women who sacrificed their lives for our freedoms are remembered. N.A.B.O.'s WWII Special Committee is seeking your club's active participation and support to spread the word about our plans to complete the research on WWII American veterans of Basque descent and eventually establish a physical memorial honoring these Basque WWII veterans. N.A.B.O. has launched a fundraising campaign to cover the costs of the final stage of research by


