LA ORGANIZACIÓN INDEPENDIENTE SOCIALE

La Organización Independiente Sociale (LOIS) was formed in 1933 by a combination of immigrants and first generation Basque pioneer women in order to support women taking care of their families. There were already two organizations of this kind that were open to men only, in our area. This club was open to Women only and in subsequent years non-Basques married to Basque men. In its heyday, there were approximately 300 members of LOIS. The organization's chief goal was to provide a source of money to help families with funeral expenses in the event of the death of a member. Financial support for the group was provided by annual dues, special one time collections, dances, dinners and get-togethers such as picnics. As the years progressed, the economy improved, people became more mobile, and membership numbers decreased. Closed to new members in 1980's-a formality only as there had been no inquiries for years—a study revealed the average age of members was 76! In late 2024, a survey of members was done and there was a unanimous vote to dissolve LOIS. Membership at that time was 50 women. Once the members received their benefits, the remaining monies were divided between two tax exempt entities, chosen by LOIS board as well as membership: both Euzkaldunak and the Basque Museum & Cultural Center received equal donations from the Organization. LOIS officers have requested that the donation be applied to improving the kitchen area and adding a donation plaque to honor LOIS in perpetua. The same founders of LOIS 92 years ago were later constant fixtures in the Basque Center kitchen serving meals for the membership. We remain grateful to our pioneer Amumas!
