SAN INAZIO PILOTA FESTIVAL

Forty-two players from Boise, San Francisco, Chino, and Euskal Herria participated in a Basque Pilota Festival during San Inazio. In-person attendees, as well as virtual viewers around the world via online streaming, had an opportunity to watch competitive pala and esku pilota games and a tournament featuring professional women's esku pilota players. The Euskal Herria 4 1/2 handball tournament featured Olatz Arrizabalaga, Enara Gaminde, Amaia Alday and Itxaso Erasun, with Enara Gaminde becoming this year's Txapeldun. The tournament was made possible with the help of Lur Intxaurtza of the Munduko Pilota Batzarra (MPB), in order to bring elite women players to Boise with the intention to promote pilota among the younger generations, and especially among girls.


BASQUE MUSEUM EUSKARA CLASSES

UDALEKU 2025

In 2025, Euzkaldunak offered partial scholarships to local Basque children who were interested in attending Udaleku (held this summer in Elko, Nevada). Formerly known as Music Camp, Udaleku came into being in April 1974 when various Basque clubs joined together to create the North American Basque Organizations, Inc. (NABO) with the purpose of promoting and encouraging our common Basque heritage. Since those early days the bonds between Basques in the United States have been strengthened and extended. The annual Udaleku, sponsored by NABO and hosted by one of our member organizations, has contributed much to this growth. The first camp was held in Boise, Idaho (Bogus Basin) in 1975. Since then, hundreds of young Basques have gathered for two weeks each summer in a different city of the extended Basque community in the United States. Under the direction of local and visiting talent from Europe, participants study Basque folk dance, music, singing, and games (such as mus and pala). Besides being a good learning experience, the camp offered the participants a great opportunity to develop ties and friendships with other young Basques from many states whose parents and ancestors came from both the northern and southern parts of Euskal Herria. The relationships they formed increase the present and future interaction between all of our Basque clubs. Those who received partial Euzkaldunak scholarships in 2025 were Jimmy & Johnny Aldape, Nerea & Oihana Arana, and Jaione & Alois Krakau.
