The November Morzilla dinner is scheduled for Saturday, November 8, 2025, as part of the annual Euzkaldunak Bazaar & Bingo Night. The dinner will be hosted by Boiseko Gazteak & Txantxangorriak. The Morzilla dinner is open to the public, and no reservations are required. It will be a "first come, first served" meal. The first seating will begin at 5:15 PM, and the second seating will begin at 6:30 PM. The price for dinner is \$25 for adults (Members & Guests) and \$10 for children 10 and under. Wine and other beverages can be purchased in the dining room.

Please note: There is no babysitting at the Basque Center during the Morzilla dinner.

MORZILLA MAKING INFORMATION

Each year, Euzkaldunak relies on the help of our volunteer members to prep, cook, and package Morzillak (blood sausage) to serve at the November Dinner and vacuum pack for sale. We would love your help this year! This is a great event that combines community, food, drink, and the feel of the fall harvest. No experience required! The Basque tradition of making morzilla stems from a zero-waste philosophy, where all animal parts are used to create a nourishing dish. The process involves mixing fresh pork or sheep blood with fillers like rice or leeks and fat, then seasoning with regional spices. The mixture is stuffed into casings, boiled to coagulate the blood, and then often fried, baked, or used in stews. This custom is a strong community tradition, often undertaken during the fall "Morzilla" festivals, to honor the pig and preserve cultural heritage.

Tuesday, November 4, 8:30 AM-4 PM

We will start at Fiddlers Green Farm (14440 Broken Horn Rd, Boise, ID 83714) picking, cleaning, and chopping the leeks and onions. The farm is on the corner of Broken Horn and W. Echanove Drive but the entrance faces Echanove Drive. Park inside the gates. Lunch will be served at 12:30 PM.

Wednesday, November 5

We will be cooking the onions and leeks from 7 AM-6 PM at the Basque Center. There are two shifts, 7 AM-1 PM and 1-6 PM and a lunch will be served at the break, at approximately 12:30 PM.

MORZILLA MAKING, CONTINUED

Thursday, November 6

We will meet at the Basque Center to make the Morzillak in two shifts: 7 AM–12:30 PM and 1–5 PM. A lunch for both shifts will be served at the break, at approximately 12:30 PM.

Friday, November 7

We will be packaging the newly-made Morztillak at the Basque Center from 9:30 AM–3 PM. To volunteer, please contact Sean Aucutt at 208-371-3090. Simple texts of times wanting to volunteer are great! Voicemails work as well. Eskerrik Asko! Sean seriously encourages folks who can't work due to advanced age or injury to still come and eat lunch with us on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. Our stories, our presence, and our bad jokes, are all reminders of what brings us together!














EUZKALDUNAK WANTS YOU!

The directors of Basque Foundation Inc. are eager to recruit directors with fresh perspectives and ideas. Every year there are five vacant positions up for election. All directors are elected to a two-year term. The 2026-2028 board of directors election will be held in January 2026 using the secure and restricted online voting software, ElectionBuddy. This platform, originally approved by the Board in 2022, ensures that all members can participate in the vote, not just those who attend the January dinner. We are requesting that nominations be turned into the corporation secretary (secretary@basquecenter.com) no later than December 20, 2025. While nominations will be taken from the floor at the members-only dinner on January 24, 2026, nominations made prior to the dinner allow the secretary to verify each nominee and to enter photos and biographies of the candidates into the election software. Those nominated from the floor will need to have their photo taken and submit a short biography before they leave the Basque Center after the dinner and meeting. NO voting will take place at the meeting. Instead, all candidates will be entered into the software and ballots will be sent to EACH Euzkaldunak member. Ballots will be sent via US Mail, text message, or email depending on the information listed in our database. Electronic voting allows each member a vote. The software counts the votes and a report is sent to the secretary. There is no hand counting. The board feels this to be a more fair, secure, and accurate method. BASQUES IN WWII MEMORIAL

NABO's WWII Memorial Committee is currently accepting bids for cities that would like to be the future host of the Basques in WWII Memorial. The bids will be due by November 30, 2025, with the goal of dedicating the memorial by the first week of December 2026, the 85th anniversary of the U.S. entering WWII. The Committee's mission "is to honor the valor, sacrifice, and enduring legacy of Basque WWII veterans, recognizing their profound contributions to freedom and democracy. Through commemorations, education, and advocacy, we pledge to ensure their stories are remembered, their sacrifices acknowledged, and their courage celebrated for generations to come." The organization working on this project has identified 2,100 Basque WWII veterans. including 327 from Idaho. The Committee is looking for a city to help coordinate building and maintenance of the memorial, including these elements:

- Public (city, county, or state) property with public access and parking
- Plan for long-term maintenance of the memorial
- Partnership with NABO's WWII committee, in terms of the design of the monument, materials, costs, and funding
- Regarding the design, this could be a product of an open competition or the work of a specialized company
- Funds available or donations to cover the costs of the physical monument, which depends on factors, such as, materials, labor, and location
- Proximity to an existing Basque monument or display


